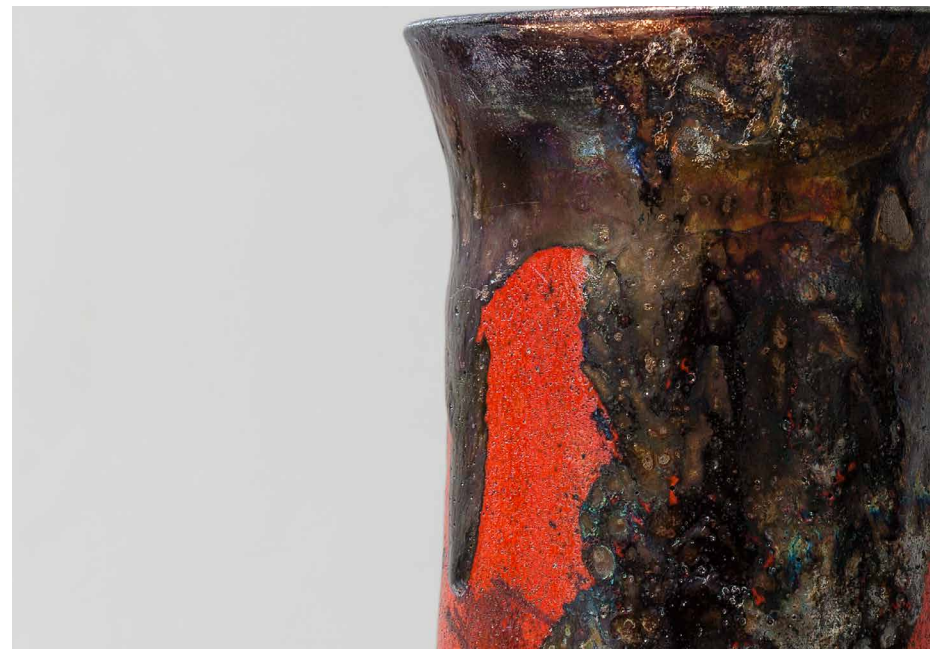

NAKED RAKU-WATER REDUCTION #1, 2015



Raku in Japanese means happiness, wellness and fun. It's an antique Japanese technique related to the tea ceremony that provides a particular decoration. The objects are first engobed, then enamelled, finally cooked in a conventional manner. After the abrupt cooling in water the layer of engobe melts revealing colorful shades.
